Incident: There have been several instances in the country including Saratoga Spring and the Capital region where unsuspecting college age students have been "friended" by subjects who portray themselves as wanting to establish a relation Ashipe conversations continue the victims are requested to visit each other via Skype or other video Wedia the victims agree theyra talked into participating in activity (often sexual in nature) that could be embarrassing if made public Inknown to the victims is that the perpetrators are video recording the Skype interaction. Immediately afterwards, the perpetrator sends at frampsho the interaction and demands money to be sent to an account or the video will be posted on Facebook. The perpetrators may also ask for credit card and personal information as well.

<u>Investigation</u>: Local police agencies are involved in investigatimese incidents which constitutes serious criminal activity.

Recommendations:

- x Do NOT participate in any activity on the internet with subjects you do not in fact know.
- x Do NOT provide any personal information on the Internet that could be used in this o any other type of criminal activity.
- x Ask yourself what would happen if the information or activity you are participating in should become public and do not implicitly trust anyone you do not know on any form of social media.
- x It is furtherrecommended that anyone who may have been involved in this type of criminal scam contact Campus Safety and local law enforcerffertu are the victim of this type of crime is also requested to provide any information to authorities so that you exposure can be lineit as much as possible.
