Peer Visitation Feedback Rubric

The rubric is not meant to be an evaluative instrument but a tool for providing feedback to peers for classroom visits. There are five teaching categories:

Classroom climate

Organization and pace of session

Promoting student understanding and retention

Providing student evaluation and feedback

Promoting self-directed learning

Associated with each category are questions that address key components of each of the categories. These questions can help peer visitors anchor their observations and provide a focus for follow-up debriefing conversations.

Teaching Category: Promoting Student Understanding and Retention
This category addresses the teacher's approach to explaining content, having students meaningfully
interact with that content, and promote understanding and remembering of content.

What is the evidence that the teacher is appropriately prepared for the class session?
