Students whose GPA is below 3.0 would be able to petition CAS for an exception, in the same way that students seeking to study abroad can do. CAS also agreed to mirror study abroad practices relating to maturity level credit obtained by students on exchange; i.e., Skidmore will accept all maturity level credit that has been approved by the appropriate academic department(s).

- x Culture-Centered Inquiry Requirement – CAS recommended to the Committee on Education Policies and Planning that students no longer be permitted to substitute courses for the culture-centered inquiry requirement, based on their experience in non-Western cultures. CEPP agreed that the culture-centered inquiry requirement is much broader than the previous Western requirement, and that all students, regardless of background, would benefit taking courses that allow them to enhance their ability to engage in intercultural interaction.
