**Motion:** CEPP moves that the faculty terminate the affiliation with the Cardozo School  
May 31, 2007.

**Rationale**

during the summers before and after their senior year. They then enroll full time as  
second year law students during the fall after graduating from Skidmore.

population (it has been more than ten years since any Skidmore student participated in the  
program):

- 1) students receive no preference in terms of admission to Cardozo Law School
- 2) students receive no tuition break by participating in the program
- 3) students are obligated to attend Cardozo Law School when, in fact, they may be better served by going elsewhere
- 4) the program is not unique to Skidmore. Cardozo maintains this arrangement with many other colleges and universities
