

4. Evaluate and monitor protocols for use of animals in teaching and research.
5. Review and investigate concerns involving the care and use of animals from within and outside of the institution.
6. Make recommendations to the IO on any aspect of the institutions program or facilities.
7. Maintain required records, including: minutes, protocols, amendments to protocols, and reports, recommendations and minority views forwarded to the IO.
