- 4. Evaluate and monitor protocols for use of animals in teaching and research.
- 5. Review and investigate concerns involving the care and use of animals from within and outside of the institution.
- 6. Make recommendations to the IO on any aspect of the institutions program or facilities.
- 7. Maintain required records, including: minutes, protocols, amendments to protocols, and reports, recommendations and minority views forwarded to the IO.
