for Providing Feedback on Written Work 1

The Government department has adopted a code of notation for providing students with feedback on their written work. Your instructor will employ the following notation system to identify unclear constructions, grammatical, punctuation, and usage errors. If, for example, your paper includes a sentence in which the subject and verb fail to agree either in number (singular or plural) or in person (first, second, or third), your instructor will underline or circle the offending sentence and place the number "3." This notation will direct you to the #3 in the code below, which will find the chapter(s), section(s), and in some cases, pages in section 1.7 of The Hodges Harbrace Handbook (referenced as Hodges) that both describe this error and offer instructions for how to correct it.
