#### I. Purpose

Thepurposeof this policy is to setforth the requirements applicable to all drivers of Skidmore College owned, leased, or rented vehicles or of personal vehicles while on College business. This policy is intended to ensure the safety of drivers, passengers, and the public, as well as to minimize losses, damages, and claims o Ds,k

- A. No one will be allowed to drive for Skidmore College with a "probationary," "court-restricted (for any conviction noted in Item I-B)" or "junior" license.
- B. Tobe authorized to drive for the College the following criteria wilbe applied:

Participatingin an unlawful speedcontest

Eludingor attempting to elude a policeofficer

Operating with a suspendedicense

Usingamotor vehiclefor commission of afelony
