A summary of the Committees work this year is as follows:

1. WorkplaceAccidentReduction:

The Committee continues to focus considerable attention to reducing work place accidents. Unfortunately, the accident numbers continue to climb, with 2010 YTD recording an all time high for the number of lost work days. New initiatives such as the reward program for departments who don't experience dost work days within a 90 day period have been largely unsuccessful attemming this tide. A subcommittee has been created to look at this issue in depth and to identify other actions that can make an impact. The subcommittee has begun reviewing each accident and its root cause in detail, looking for trends and patterns that may have been previously missed. Safety
